St Augustine's Church is a Church of England church, in the Anglo-Catholic tradition.

Now an English Heritage listed building, St Augustine's was designed by the renowned Victorian architect, William Butterfield (1814-1900). In deliberate contrast to Prince Albert's cream boulevards of Queen's Gate, Butterfield purposefully used different coloured brick and set the church at an angle to the lines of the surrounding buildings. The first building stage began in 1871 and the church was completed in 1876.

The interior of the church is well worth a visit, we regret that we cannot keep the church open at all times. The church is usually open:

Sunday 1-3pm

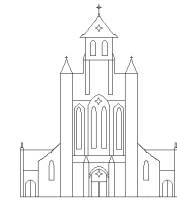
Tuesday 2-4pm
